

Group Search Buying Guide

Thank you for your interest in RIT Safety Solutions Group Search Kits! See Below for all the questions you should investigate before purchasing!

1. What Kind of Rope Do I need?

- a. RIT Safety has 3 different kinds of ropes used in our Group Search kits. Most commonly used is our 9.5mm Rope Kevlar over poly, but we also have 7.5mm 100% Kevlar rope and 6mm Kevlar over poly Rope that has also been utilized on several occasions in our kits!

2. What Length of Rope do I need?

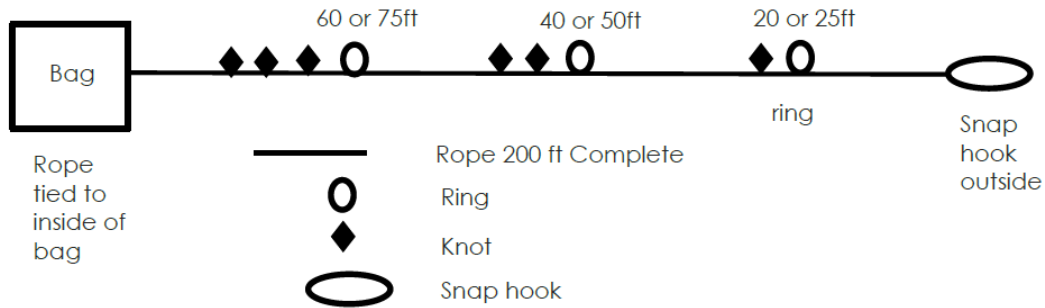
- a. We offer different group search kits with 100ft, 200ft, or 300ft lengths of any of our rope!

3. Do I need knots and rings on the system? And What lengths are they located at?

- a. Knots and ring systems are used to help tell distance and direction and help the user when entering and exiting any building or area! Having a marker system is strongly suggested in most cases!



- b. The Knots and ring Marker system can be at every 20ft a ring followed by a knot, or every 25ft. We can also do any variation of the knot and ring system your department is used to! Just draw us a diagram and we can follow your design!



4. Should I get tag lines and what lines are offered?

- a. Tag Lines are helpful when you have more than one User attached to the line, these are suggested for larger units! Used with our knot and ring system for several different tie off locations!
- b. For standard manual tag lines, we have 4 options: 25ft of tubular 7/16th webbing with snap hook (our most common seen in our kits), or a 35ft, 50ft or 65ft of tubular 7/16th webbing with a Steel Carabiner.



- c. For Retractable Lines we have a 20ft 6mm Rope Retractable, or a 50ft 6mm Rope Retractable option.
